Syrah du Monde® Awards Medals to World's Best Syrah/Shiraz Wines

The 18th edition of the Syrah du Monde® international wine competition, organized by Forum Œnologie, has just come to an end. Over the course of two days, international experts tasted 214 Syrah/Shiraz wines from all over the world. Diversity and quality are the watchwords for the 2024 winners, which comes as no surprise for a grape variety currently enjoying rapid growth. Optimal tasting conditions enabled the international judges to award 71 medals (26 gold, 45 silver) that are recognized as a reliable criterion for selection.

May 23-24, 2024, in Ampuis Castle of Ampuis, France, Syrah du Monde® international wine competition recognized the world's best Syrah/Shiraz wines, awarding reliable and representative medals. This competition is founded on a single conviction that distinctive marks of quality are the key to differentiation and to the promotion of medal-winning wines in a highly competitive and often complex marketplace. Medal-winning wineries can use their medals to develop the recognized quality of their wines.

Syrah du Monde® 2024 brought together 214 wines from 18 countries, making this competition one of the world's top events for Syrah/Shiraz wines. This marvellous success illustrates the impressive growth that this Rhone varietal has enjoyed since the 1970s.

Syrah du Monde® has carved out a place of its own amongst wine competitions, thanks to its international flavour and its rigorous methods. During the two days of tasting under optimal conditions, the international expert judges awarded 71 medals in accordance with international wine competition regulations. Syrah du Monde® has progressively distinguished itself from other international competitions thanks to quality standards that are much stricter than the norm and by remaining faithful to its founding principles: diversity, quality and high standards.

Highlights 2024

Geographical diversity: With representation from 18 countries and 214 wines, Syrah du Monde® offers a variety of Syrah/Shiraz wines rarely equalled in competitions of this level. This makes it one of the most significant and legitimate qualitative competitions in recognizing the world's best Syrah/Shiraz wines.

A strong participation of wines from Australia, Italy, Portugal, South-Africa, Spain, Switzerland.

From France, the good participation of Languedoc-Roussillon, Provence and the northern and southern Rhone Valley is noted with a lower participation of rosés wines.

Medal-Winning Countries

Nine countries are included in the 2024 Top 10: Australia, Chile, France, Greece, Italy, Portugal, Spain, South Africa and Switzerland.

Diversity of Sensorial Expression

Each of the wines that distinguished themselves at Syrah du Monde® did so because of their own distinctive quality, not in comparison to other wines. A favorable score was given to wines with good Syrah varietal character, and a well-balanced oak was considered to be a plus. However, oakiness was marked down if it masked varietal aromas and flavours.
